## **A Rotary Minute 3-1-07 from Tony Wong**

Rotary Youth Exchange student Etta Turner was on a bus in the mountains of Bolivia in 2002 when their driver fell asleep. 21 passenger died, including Turner.

Rotary Club of Montero, Bolivia started a community center dedicated to Turner and provided food, education, and health care to children.

When Turner's mother found out about it, she created a non-profit project, together with funds from The Rotary Foundation, to fund the center. A second center was opened this year that feeds 200 children.
