Paul Harris was writing about our fourth object of Rotary then (known as the sixth object) in 1925 and spent some time discussing some of the various friends he had met through the Rotary movement from all parts of the world.

Today, it seem clear to me, that the best way to make friends from all over the world is to get involved with our Rotary Fellowships – Rotarian Action Groups or Global Networking Groups. <http://www.rotary.org/programs/fellowships/index.html> The work that these organizations carry out is vast and varied and there is a group for you!

Through our Rotary Fellowships long-lasting and lifelong friendships can be made. Our first object of Rotary states that acquaintance is an opportunity for service and any club member can see the obvious truth in that statement by considering her or his own club. Rotary Fellowships allows the Rotarian to take a step further and make friends on an international basis.

For example, Rotary Global History Fellowship is a worldwide fellowship of over 130 members based in more than 30 countries. It is not just a grouping of like-minded individuals. RGHF has opened doors for many Rotarians around the world and directly led to successful matching grant projects and Group Study Exchanges to name but two developments.

Other fellowships can boast of similar successes. Never underestimate the power of global networking!

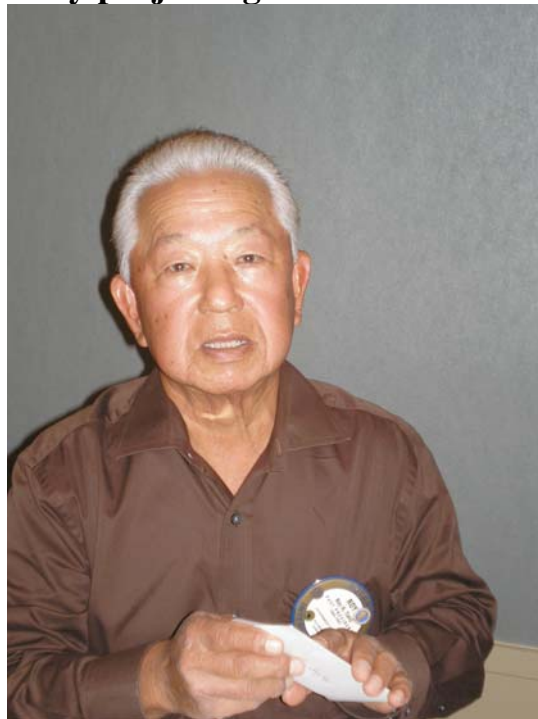
